Our priority is to make sure everyone remains safe and does not get out if not needed. Please use good judgment before venturing out in any kind of inclement weather.

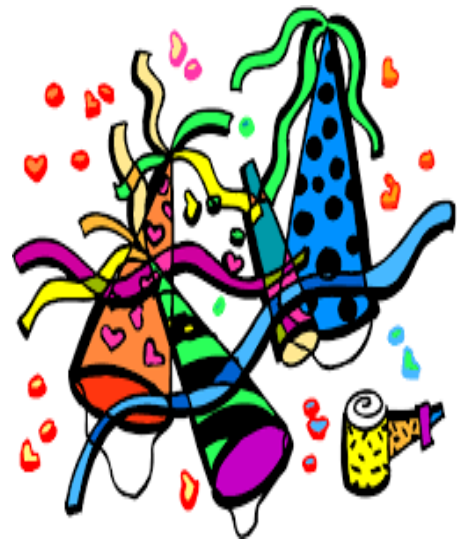
